Other Action/Discussion Items:

1. 2019-2020 Road Improvement Recommendations: Town Engineer Swicegood reviewed the completed Road Condition Survey and recommendations for paving in FY2019-20. The recommended paving includes Spruce Hill Road, Seaton Lane, Mentor School Road, McCarty Road, Ty Drive, Byrd Drive, and Haven Hill Road. The BMA reviewed the recommendations and proceeded to vote on approval.

MOTION by Gormley to approve the recommendations for FY2019-20 paving for inclusion in the budget planning process for FY2019-20. Second by Smith. VOTE: UNANIMOUS.

Town Engineer Swicegood will begin preparation of the bid documents based on the approved recommendations. Bid documents will be issued in May after approval on First Reading of the FY2019-20 budget. This schedule will insure that paving can begin in July-August 2019.
