There will be a float competition for this 2019 Christmas parade. The categories will be as follows:

GRAND PRIZE

Trophy awarded for the best overall entry, commercial or non-commercial, selected following the parade. This entry must be of a patriotic nature.

MAYOR'S AWARD

Non-commercial entry which best depicts the parade theme, chosen before parade begins at the lineup area, between 10:00 and 10:30 a.m.. Winner will be placed behind Mayor's car in the parade lineup.


SPIRIT AWARD

Presented to the entry which best personifies a spirit of dedication, ingenuity, originality and enthusiasm, and brings the greatest pleasure to and response from the spectators.

Judging panel will be selected by the Mayor or Town Manager.

1. Theme 1-20 points
2. Overall appearance 1-30 points
3. Originality & Creativity 1-15 points
4. Music (canned: 1-10 points, live 10 – 20 points) 20points
5. Crowd appeal 1-15 points
6. Possible total points 100 points
