Mayor Bickers called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Mayor Bickers led the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

**MOTION** by Gormley to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2020 meeting of the BMA. Second by Smith. VOTE: UNANIMOUS. **MOTION PASSES.**

**Mayor's Report and Approval of Monthly Financial Report:**

Financial report for month ending May 31 was reviewed.

**MOTION** by Holley to accept the May monthly financial report. Second by Gormley. VOTE: UNANIMOUS. **MOTION PASSES.**

Mayor Bickers communicated the Music Festival has been cancelled after being postponed to September 11 &12 due to the pandemic. The decision was reached in consensus with all promoters. The town will receive reimbursement from all the entertainers. Government guidelines for large events such as this would make acceptable execution virtually impossible. A press release will be forthcoming this week and all ticket receipts will be refunded.

Mayor Bickers communicated that the status for the Octoberfest event unknown at this time. We will wait a month before making a decision whether to go forward or cancel the October 17 event.

Mayor Bickers reported on the continuing progress being made on the Dog Park at Beal Park. Town crews have completed the fencing at better than half the quoted cost. Dog toys are being constructed and put into place. More work remains to be done but a possible grand opening will be held in October.

**Citizens Comments:** Steven Kelly inquired whether there was a possibility of doing a smaller music festival in the fall.

**Ordinance 2020-01 Passes.**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF LOUISVILLE, TENNESSEE, ADOPTING AN AMENDED CONTINUING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEARS ENDING IN 2020 & 2021 (Final Reading)

Mayor Bickers reviewed the need for the continuing budget as a result of uncertainty caused by the pandemic. Budget needs will be reviewed in September after financial revenue data is better known.

**MOTION** by Gormley to approve the ordinance as proposed. Second by Smith.  
**VOTE: UNANIMOUS. MOTION PASSES**

**Ordinance 2020-02 Passes.**

**Other Action/Discussion Items:**

1. Approval of Bids for Road Improvements 2020 -2021: Town Engineer Swicegood reviewed bids received from Patty Construction, Harrison Inc, Duracap and PRI. All these bidders have performed work for the TOL and all were acceptable for this year's work. Patty Construction submitted the low bid at \$255,161 with Harrison Inc. a close second at \$284,196. The Town Engineer recommended that the contract be awarded to Patty Construction since they were the low bidder by a margin of almost \$30,000.

**MOTION** by Gormley to approved awarding the 2020-2021 Road Improvement contract to Patty Construction. Second by Smith. VOTE: UNANIMOUS.

**MOTION PASSES**

Town Engineer Swicegood will contact Patty Construction on June 10 to notify that they were the successful bidder and set up communication to begin working on a schedule.
