Mayor Bickers called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Other Action Items:

1. Review and Approve Proposal for Town of Louisville - Community Park - Phase 1 Design:
Mayor Bickers reviewed the quotation submitted by T Square Engineering on March 01, 2022 for development Phase 1 documentation. The submitted total was \$48,750 for development of the design and construction documents for the Community Park's Phase 1 area. Mayor Bickers also reported on the meeting conducted at MES to gather input from teachers and students for the playground facility to be incorporated into the Phase 1 area. Alderman Pugh raised several questions regarding scope of the design, how community input will be included in the design, what amenities will be in the final design, whether this project is in the current budget and whether this project will qualify for ARPA funding. Mayor Bickers affirmed that all of Alderman Pugh's concerns will be addressed as the project moves forward. The current budget for capital projects of \$150,000 will cover this \$48,750 design commitment.

MOTION by Bickers to authorize T Square Engineering to proceed with design of Phase 1 as proposed. Second by Gormley. VOTE: UNANIMOUS. **MOTION PASSES**

MOTION by Gormley to adjourn the meeting; Second by Kelley, VOTE: UNANIMOUS.
